Location

The prefecture is situated in eastern Shikoku, with Kagawa Prefecture to the north and Ehime Prefecture and Kochi Prefecture to the west. It is also connected to Awaji Island in Hyogo Prefecture by the Onaruto Bridge (Naruto Strait Bridge).

Climate

The climate varies significantly between the regions north and south of Mt. Tsurugi. Tokushima City in the north is temperate with little rain. Kaiyo in the south receives heavy rainfall throughout the year. The mountainous region experiences dramatic temperature fluctuations.

AREA 03

Coexistence of nature and history

Western Area

This area lies at the northern foot of Mt. Tsurugi, the second highest mountain in western Japan. In the north flows Yoshino River, with the towns concentrated along its banks. Highlights include the Iya Valley and Oboke and Koboke in Miyoshi, and the Udatu townscape in Mima.

The political and economic center of Tokushima

Tokushima City Area

Bordering the Yoshino River basin and the Kii Channel, this area comprises three municipalities: Tokushima city, the prefectural capital; Matsushige, where the airport is located; and Komatsushima, a port town and home to many commuters. 1 Classic Route for 4 Days and 3 Nights

This route takes you to two major tourist spots, Naruto and Oboke-lya. Designed for travel using public transportation, the journey will take 4 days and 3 nights if connections go smoothly.

DAY 1 Tour Naruto's Top Attractions

Take the local bus from Tokushima Station and spend the morning visiting the Naruto Whirlpools and the Otsuka Museum of Art. After lunch near Naruto Station, visit Ryozen-ji. Enjoy a relaxing night at a resort hotel.



From Oboke-lya, take the local bus and the JR Dosan Line to Awa-Ikeda Station, and then take the JR Tokushima Line to Tokushima Station. On the way, visit the historic Udatu townscape in Mima. Once in Tokushima City, hop from café to izakaya pub, and end the evening with Awa Odori

The journey by car takes a day less, 3 days and 2 nights. In this case, stay in Oboke-lya on the first night and in Tokushima City on the second.



The trip to Oboke-lya can be made by train from JR Naruto Station, but is time-consuming due to connections between the Naruto Line, Tokushima Line, and Dosan Line. The express bus is recommended.



There are also many restaurants in the Awa-Ikeda Station area including Yachiyo, a popular diner known for their Ramen and set meals.


A local dish of Iya, "Dekomawashi" consists of potatoes, Iya Tofu, and Konjac skewered and grilled with Miso. Its name comes from its resemblance to the "Deko" (foreheads) of the puppets used in Awa Ningyo Joruri.

1 See the **Naruto Whirlpools**

The whirlpools that form in the Naruto Strait are among the largest in the world! They appear just beneath the Onaruto Bridge between Shikoku and Awaji Island, and can be seen from observation decks and sightseeing boats.

HOW TO Whirlpool Watching

There are three popular ways to see the whirlpools, each with its own appeal.

1 Sightseeing Boats

The sightseeing boats are ideal for a close-up view of the whirlpools. Operated by two companies, the boats are available in a range of sizes, from large to small.







The Naruto Whirlpools are formed by the tides and do not occur throughout the day. They are most likely to appear about 1 hr and 30 min before and after both low tide and high tide. Check the tide chart on the sightseeing boat websites.



The dock for the Hyotan-jima Riverboat Cruise is located in Shinmachi Riverside Park, and the base station of the Bizan Ropeway to Mt. Bizan's summit is on the 5th floor of the Awa Odori Kaikan.

7 Try Awa Indigo Dyeing



Tokushima's indigo has been cultivated in the Yoshino River basin since the Edo period and is recognized as the highest quality in the country. Even today, the tradition is passed down by expert artisans called "Aishi". Workshops offering indigo-dyeing experiences can be found throughout the area.



Shikoku Pilgrimage

Founded by Kobo Daishi, the Shikoku Pilgrimage is a spiritual journey taking you to 88 temples, called "Fudasho"

Tokushima, where the pilgrimage begins

The first temple of the Shikoku Pilgrimage, which spans four prefectures, is located in Tokushima. This first temple, Ryozen-ji, is called the "Temple of the Vow," while the pilgrimage temples in Tokushima Prefecture are called "Dojo of Awakening." Visiting all 88 temples completes the pilgrimage. However, it has become more common in recent years to visit only some of the temples.

Route and distance

The total distance to visit all 88 temples is about 1,400 km. Tokushima has 23 of the 88 temples.

How to worship

1 Bow at the Sanmon gate and enter the temple grounds

At the Sanmon gate, which is the entrance to the sanctuary, bow to the Buddha.



2 Purify at the Temizuya (purification fountain)

First wash your left hand, then your right hand, and finally rinse your mouth.



3 Offer light and incense at the main hall

Make an offering of a votive candle and incense at the designated spot.



4 Offer a prayer slip and coins

Fill out the prayer slip in the main hall and place it in the designated box.




5 Read sutras

Facing the principal image, bow with your hands together and chant sutras.

At the heart of Tokushima's traditional performing arts is Awa Ningyo Joruri, established around 1600.

Awa Ningyo Joruri is a stage performance in which puppeteers, three to a single puppet, a *Tayu* (narrator), and *Shamisen* players work together as one. At the Awa Jurobe Yashiki, puppet shows are held twice a day.

By the early Edo period, the prototype of Awa Odori had already taken shape and was widely danced by the local townspeople. The dance consists of three elements: the boldly expressive *Otoko Odori* (men's dance); the graceful, perfectly synchronized *Onna Odori* (women's dance); and *Narimono*, the ensemble of musical instruments.



The Shikoku Pilgrimage is said to have a history of 1,200 years. *Goshuin* stamps can be collected at each temple.

Traditional Crafts

Tokushima's traditional crafts are rooted in everyday life. Experience the art of handcrafting at workshops that preserve time-honored methods.

Awa indigo supported the finances of the feudal domain during the Edo period. Indigo plants cultivated in the Yoshino River basin were processed into a dye called "Sukumo" and distributed throughout the country. Dyeing workshops in Aizumi and Itano, where the indigo is produced, offer hands-on experiences.






